About the documentary review

The university is seeking approval for an additional cohort to their existing degree apprenticeship but for the additional cohort to be taught at their satellite campus site, Coventry University London. The university has provided evidence in support of this change request which has been reviewed by the allocated inspectors.

Findings

The inspectors have reviewed the documentary evidence and consider;

- That there are no changes to the course design that impact on Social Work England standards.

- There is a good working relationship between the university and the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham with clear timelines indicated for the task and finish group and interview activities.
- There is a well-balanced and adequate number of appropriately qualified and experienced staff in place to deliver an effective course.
- Adequate student support mechanisms and resources in place at the satellite site and there are clear pathways for students to raise issues, concerns and general feedback.

Conclusions

The inspectors are recommending approval of the changes.
