About the review

As part of a wider review into their social work provision, the Keele University course team looked at the number of credits and assessments that make up the MA Social Work course and found that it was not representative of the standard credits required for this level of degree. In order to lessen the assessment burden on students whilst in placement the course team have removed credits from some modules and removed the academic assignment elements, leaving pass/fail portfolios in place.



Findings

The inspectors have reviewed documentary evidence submitted in support of the changes, including:

- updated module descriptors
- placement handbook
- portfolio content information
- learning agreement

The inspectors are satisfied that the module and course learning outcomes will continue to be met as part of the changes made to the module assessments. The portfolios allow students to evidence capability in practice and include feedback from service users.

There are clear quality assurances measures in place ensuring monitoring and evaluation of the portfolios is robust.

The inspectors are satisfied that all affected standards will continue to be met as a result of these changes.

Conclusions

The inspectors are recommending approval of the changes.
